Introduction:

and that they have devoted themselves for ministry to the saints),

#3-Seek to be \_\_\_\_\_

that you also be in subjection to such men and to everyone who helps in the work and labors.

#4-Give \_\_\_\_\_

And I rejoice over the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus; because they have supplied what was lacking on your part. For they have refreshed my spirit and yours.

#5-Show \_\_\_\_\_

Therefore acknowledge such men.

#6-Be \_\_\_\_\_

The churches of Asia greet you. Aquila and Prisca greet you heartily in the Lord, with the church that is in their house. All the brethren greet you.

#7-Give \_\_\_\_\_  
Greet one another with a holy kiss.

#8-Make \_\_\_\_\_ your life  
The greeting is in my own hand--Paul. If anyone does not love the Lord, let him be accursed. Maranatha.  
The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you. My love be with you all in Christ Jesus. Amen.
