Matthew 3:17 *This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased.*

1 Timothy 1:11 *according to the glorious gospel of the blessed God!*

John 15:11 *These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full*

John 17:13 *these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy made full in themselves.*

John 17:26 *I have made Thy name known to them, and will make it known; that the love wherewith Thou didst love Me may be in them, and I in them.*

Romans 8:20 *creation was subjected to futility, 22 For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now.*

Isaiah 11:6-9 *And the wolf will dwell with the lamb, And the leopard will lie down with the kid, And the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little boy will lead them. 7 Also the cow and the bear will graze; Their young will lie down together; And the lion will eat straw like the ox. 8 And the nursing child will play by the hole of the cobra, And the weaned child will put his hand on the viper's den. 9 They will not hurt or destroy ...*

Romans 8:21 *the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption*

2 Peter 3:13 *according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.*

Colossians 1:20 *and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, ... whether things on earth or things in heaven.*

1 John 2:19 *They went out from us, but they were not really of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but they went out, in order that it might be shown that they all are not of us.*

2 Corinthians 5:17-19 *Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 18 Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ, and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, 19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation.*

20 *Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were entreating through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God*
