14- For we know that the Law is spiritual; but I am of flesh, sold into bondage to sin.

Rom. 8:8 and those who are in the flesh cannot please God. 9 However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, ...
1 Cor 3:1 And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to babes in Christ. 3 for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like

mere men?

1 Tim 1:15 - the Chief of sinners

15 For that which I am doing, I do not understand; for I am not practicing what I would like to do, but I am doing the very thing I hate. **16** But if I do the very thing I do not wish to do, I agree with the Law, confessing that it is good. **17** So now, no longer am I the one doing it, but sin which indwells me.

18 For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh; for the wishing is present in me, but the doing of the good is not.

19 For the good that **I** wish, I do not do; but I practice the very evil that I do not wish.

20 But if I am doing the very thing I do not wish, I am no longer the one doing it, but sin which dwells in me.
