To his own master he stands or falls; and stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

Titus 2:14 ... gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Jude 1:4 For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ

11 For it is written, As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to Me, 12 So then each one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Do you not judge those who are within the church? 13 But those who are outside, God judges. Remove the wicked man from among vourselves.
