## The Pattern to Follow: Christ's suffering

IN HIS DIFFICULT STEPS part 2 and part 3, 1 Peter 2:21-25

## Introduction

21 For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example [THAT] for you to follow in His steps, 22 who committed no sin, nor was any deceit found in His mouth; 23 [WHO] and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously; 24 [WHO] and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so THAT we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed. 25 For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.
