#### 1-Know the difference between abuse and discipline

#### <u>Abuse</u>

Unfair and unexpected
Degrading and demoralizing
Extreme--too harsh or brutal
Torturous--leaves scars

Results from hatred and resentment

Creates terror, emotional damage, and resentment of authority Destroys self-esteem; leads to horrifying, permanent damage

and the inability, later in life, to maintain responsibilities

#### **Discipline**

Fair and expected
Upholds dignity
Balanced--within limits
Painful, but leaves no scars
Prompted by love and concern

Leads to a healthy respect for authority

Strengthens self-esteem; leads to the individual's ability to later discipline himself

# #1 God gave TWO key tools for parents to use to disciple their kids?

## 1<sup>st</sup> What is biblical <u>DISCIPLINE</u>?

#### \*Turn to Hebrews 12

Luke 23:16 I will therefore punish Him and release Him

Hebrews 12:6 those whom the Lord loves He disciplines, And He scourges every son whom He receives.

Revelation 3:19 Those whom I <u>love</u>, I reprove and <u>discipline</u>; be zealous therefore, and repent

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom, But a child who gets his own way brings shame to his mother

**Discipline** which is **DONE** to the child **Instruction** which is **SAID** to the child

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Never forget WHO gave parents the tool of discipline

# #2 HOW do parents use the discipline tool?

## 1st Embrace the REASON for the rod

Psalm 51:5 Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me.

Ephesians 2:2 ...the sons of disobedience 3 ... by nature children of wrath

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of discipline will remove it far from him.

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, but he who loves him disciplines him diligently

Proverbs 23:13 Do not hold back discipline from the child, Although you beat him with the rod, he will not die. 14 You shall beat him with the rod, And deliver his soul from Sheol.

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom, But a child who gets his own way brings shame to his mother.

Psalm 127:3 Behold, children are a gift of the Lord; The fruit of the womb is a reward.

1 Samuel 3:13 because his sons brought a curse on themselves and he did not rebuke them.

Proverbs 19:18 Discipline your son while there is hope, And do not desire his death.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Avoid the **EXTREMES** in using the rod

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him diligently. Revelation 3:19 Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline

## 3rd Deal with the EXCUSES about the rod

Proverbs 29:17 Correct your son, and he will give you comfort; He will also delight your soul.

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him diligently.

Proverbs 23:13 Do not hold back discipline from the child, Although you beat him with the rod, he will not die.

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## 4th Practice using the rod the way God DESIGNED

#### 1-Pursuing only BIBLICAL discipline with the rod

The rod is a parent, in faith toward God and faithfulness toward his or her children, undertaking the responsibility of careful, timely, measured and controlled use of physical punishment to underscore the importance of obeying God, thus rescuing the child from continuing in his foolishness until death.

#### 2-Use a rod, not your HAND

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him diligently.

#### 3-The rod is used to associate PAIN for disobedience, not damage

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; the rod of discipline will remove it far from him

#### 4-Use the Rod OFTEN and early

#### 5-Take the TIME to discipline biblically

STEP 1 be certain he understands what he did that was wrong

STEP 2 bring the authority of God to bear on him directly

STEP 3 help him evaluate his own actions in light of the Bible

STEP 4 help him to see when he sins, he needs to be corrected

STEP 5 show him your obligation to be God's agent in correction

STEP 6 ask him what he ought to do in the future

#### Instruction is not merely <u>SAID</u>, biblical instruction must also be <u>SHOWN</u> to a child
