Introduction:

#1 - Christ was victorious in His <u>DEATH</u> for you 18

18 For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;

#2 - Christ was victorious in His <u>PROCLAIMATION</u> over His enemies 19-20a

19 in which also He went and made proclamation to the spirits now in prison, 20 who once were disobedient,
