Phase 1 = Salvation

Andrew and Philip came and told Jesus.

John 15:16a You did not choose <u>Me but I chose you,</u> and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit

Mark 2:14 ... He saw Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting in the tax booth, and He said to him,

<u>'Follow Me!'</u> And he got up and <u>followed Him</u>

John 1:43 He found Philip. And Jesus said to him, <u>'Follow Me.'</u>

Mark 8:34 He summoned the crowd with His disciples, and said to them, 'If anyone wishes to come after Me,

#3 The Lord calls you to His LORDSHIP 18-20

1st The Lord uses <u>NORMAL</u> people

2nd The Lord is not calling you to <u>FANATICISM</u>

3rd The Lord's call to evangelism is an expression of LOVE

4th The Lord calls you first, to FOLLOW Him - are you?
