Matthew 7:28 When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were amazed at His teaching; 29 for He was teaching them as one having authority, and not as their scribes.

Titus 1:9 holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching, so that he will be able both to exhort in sound doctrine and to refute those who contradict.

1st Authoritative teaching is not OPTIONAL

2nd Christians who desire to follow God's Word must grow to be <u>DISCERNING</u> and <u>TEACHABLE</u>

2 Peter 3:17...be on your guard lest, being carried away by the error of unprincipled men Hebrews 5:14 solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil

3rd The starting place to experience God's authority in your life is to be <u>SUBMISSIVE</u>
