#2 Practice DEPENDENT obedience

Turn to Galatians 5

#3 Become adept at dealing with SIN in you and others

*Galatians 6:1 Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; each one looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted. THEN
2 Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.*

1st Step = Changing the TONE of your entire Church.

2nd Step = Discern IF and WHEN a believer should speak to another about their sin

1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

3rd Step = Practice Church Discipline in HUMILITY

1 Church discipline is COMMONPLACE

2 Church discipline is directed against DEFIANT sin

Numbers 15:27 'Also if one person sins unintentionally, then he shall offer a one year old female goat for a sin offering. 28 'The priest shall make atonement before the Lord for the person who goes astray when he sins unintentionally, making atonement for him that he may be forgiven. 29 'You shall have one law for him who does anything unintentionally, for him who is native among the sons of Israel and for the alien who sojourns among them. 30 'But the person who does anything defiantly, whether he is native or an alien, that one is blaspheming the Lord; and that person shall be cut off from among his people. 31 'Because he has despised the word of the Lord and has broken His commandment, that person shall be completely cut off; his guilt will be on him.' 3 The confronter looks only for REPENTANCE

Revelation 2:4 'But I have this against you, that you have left your first love. 5 'Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent.

4 The goal of discipline is RESTORATION and PROTECTION

Matthew 18 you have won your brother.

PERSONAL SIN *Matthew 18:15-18 and Galatians 6:1*
