2nd Seek to live under the AUTHORITY of God's Word

4th Seek to balance Truth and GRACE

5th Seek to build into your lifestyle the STUDY of the Word

6th Seek to enjoy INTIMACY with Christ through His Word

HOLDING FAST requires **ENDURANCE**;

involves a SINGULAR commitment;

Matthew 6:24 No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will hold to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

 - 1st Make sure the teacher gives evidence of diligent <u>STUDY</u>
 2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as workman who does not heed to be ashamed, handling accurately the Word of truth.
 - 2nd Following the biblical rules of <u>INTERPRETATION</u>: Hermeneutics The Bible is interpreted= Literally or normatively, Contextually, Historically, Grammatically & Synthetically
 - 3rd Make sure you hear the <u>WHOLE</u> counsel of God Acts 20:27 For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God.

#4 We exclusively use the Word to BUILD Christians to live like Christ

to exhort in sound doctrine

Ephesians 4:14...we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves, and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;

#5 We will correct ERROR with the Word and to refute those who contradict.
