Does God HEAL today and how do we understanding HEALING - from the Bible and Mark 6:53-56

Introduction:

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Matthew 9:12 It is not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are ill. Luke 10:30-37 The Samaritan used oil, wine, and bandages to help the abandoned Jew.

2 Corinthians 12:12 The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with all perseverance, by signs and wonders and miracles. Hebrews 2:4 God also testifying with them, both by signs and wonders and by various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will.

Acts 2:42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles.

- 1 Timothy 5:23 No longer drink water exclusively, but use a little wine for the sake of your stomach and your frequent ailments.
- 2 Timothy 4:20b ... Trophimus I left sick at Miletus.

Healing is noticeable in the OT (scattered over a 4,000 year period).

Healing is overwhelming in the Gospels (in a three and a half year period).

Healing is occasional in Acts (in a thirty year period),

Healing is negligible in the Epistles (in a forty year period).

The gift of healing?

It was immediate. It was public. It took place on ordinary, unplanned occasions. It included illnesses that were untreatable by the medical community. It was complete and irreversible. It was undeniable, even by detractors and enemies.

Mark 6:53 When they had crossed over they came to land at Gennesaret, and moored to the shore. 54 When they got out of the boat, immediately the people recognized Him, 55 and ran about that whole country and began to carry here and there on their pallets those who were sick, to the place they heard He was. 56 Wherever He entered villages, or cities, or countryside, they were laying the sick in the market places, and imploring Him that they might just touch the fringe of His cloak; and as many as touched it were being cured
