#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Sin hurts us and destroys our HAPPINESS

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Sin causes our <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> to be broken

## 1<sup>st</sup> Remember Christ has already <u>PAID</u> for our sin

### 2<sup>nd</sup> CONFESS your sin

**1** John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> <u>ACCEPT</u> God's forgiveness, forgive yourself and press on in your pursuit of Christlikeness
