Introduction

#### #1 The CIRCUMSTANCES for clarification on divorce 1

1 Getting up, He went from there to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan; crowds gathered around Him again, and, according to His custom, He once more began to teach them.

#### #2 The CONFRONTATION over the question of divorce 2

2 Some Pharisees came up to Jesus, testing Him, and began to question Him whether it was lawful for a man to divorce a wife

#### #3 CLARIFYING the true authority on divorce 3-4

3 And He answered and said to them, "What did Moses command you? 4 They said, "Moses permitted a man to write a certificate of divorce and send her away."

5 But Jesus said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart he wrote you this commandment.

## #7 The C of divorce 11-12

11-12 And He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another woman commits adultery against her; 12 and if she herself divorces her husband and marries another man, she is committing adultery."

#### #7 The CONSEQUENCES of divorce - continued 11-12

ONE 1 Timothy 5:14 I want younger widows to get married, bear children, keep house, and give the enemy no occasion for reproach; Romans 7:2 For a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage. 3 Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man she is not an adulteress.

TWO 2 Corinthians 5:17 if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

**THREE 1 Corinthians 7:15** Yet if the unbelieving one leaves, let him leave; the brother or the sister is <u>not under</u> bondage in such cases, but God has called us to peace.
