about yourselves, that <u>Jesus Christ is in you</u>—unless indeed you fail the test? **2 Peter 1:10** brethren, be all the more diligent to <u>make</u> <u>certain</u> about His calling and choosing you; for as long as you practice these things, you will never stumble; **Verse 5-7 says** faith, moral excellence, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love. **8** For if these qualities are <u>yours</u> and are <u>increasing</u>, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
