LUKE 24:13-35

THE WORD OF GOD:

Is Alive Heb 4:12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Purifies Psalm 119:11 Your word I have treasured in my heart, that I may not sin against You.

Guides Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

<mark>Is Valuable</mark> Psalm 119:72 The law of Your mouth is better to me than thousands of gold and silver *pieces.*

Is Desirable Psalm 119:103 How sweet are Your words to my taste! *Yes, sweeter* than honey to my mouth!

Is Eternal Isaiah 40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever.

Helps us Grow 1 Peter 2:2 Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.

Is True John 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

Leads to Salvation 2 Timothy 3:15 And that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Is Profitable 2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

First animal sacrifice Gen 3:21 The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Jesus is the substitute Gen 22:13-14 Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind *him* a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son. Abraham called the name of that place "The Lord Will Provide".

Jesus is the Passover fulfilled Exodus 11 **Jesus is the lamb and the scapegoat on the Day of Atonement** Leviticus 16 OT Prophecies about His 1st coming

Descendent of David Isaiah 11:1 <mark>Born of a virgin</mark> Isaiah 7:14 <mark>Born in Bethlehem</mark> Micah 5:2

Earthly ministry Isaiah 35:5 Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will shout for joy. Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, Because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners. (see also Matthew 11:3-5)

He enters Jerusalem on a donkey Zech 9:9 Betrayed by a friend Ps 41:9 Sold for 30 pieces of silver Zech 11:12-13 His humiliation Isaiah 50:6 I gave My back to those who strike *Me,* and My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.

Crucifixion Psalm 22:16-18 They pierced my hands and my feet. I can count all my bones. They look, they stare at Me; they divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. Isaiah 53:5-6 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. All of us like sheep have gone astray each of us has turned to his own way; but the Lord has

caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him. Ps 69:21 They also gave me gall for my food and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

Resurrection Ps 16:10 For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol; nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

OT Appearances of Christ

Exodus 3:2,6 The angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush...Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God. Gen 32:24,30 Then Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him until daybreak.... So Jacob named the place Peniel, for he said, "I have seen God face to face, yet my life has been preserved." Daniel 4:24-25 "Was it not three men we cast bound into the midst of the fire?" They replied to the king, "Certainly, O king." He said, "Look! I see four men loosed and walking about in the midst of the fire without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods!" Isaiah 6:5 My eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts. John 12:41 These things Isaiah said because he saw His glory, and he spoke of Him.

The first vs the last Adam Romans 5:14 So also it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living soul." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. 1 Cor 15:45 But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

Jesus, the better Abel Hebrews 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel.

The true light of the world John 8:12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows." Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."

The Manna from heaven John 6:49,51 Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died....I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh.

The rock which was struck 1 Corinthians 10:4 and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they were drinking from a spiritual rock which followed them; and the rock was Christ.

Lifted up for salvation John 3:14-15 As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up; so that whoever believes will in Him have eternal life.

The Final Sacrifice Hebrews 10:11-12 Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God.

Judge 2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

Prophet Hebrews 1:1-2 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Priest Hebrews 4:14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

King Rev 19:16 And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.
