Hopeful reactions immediately following the death of Christ, from The Gospel of Mark 15:38-41

Introduction

#1 A

Verse 38 And the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom

Hebrews 10:19 brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, ...22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith...

Matthew 27:51 and the earth shook and the rocks were split Psalm 68:8 The earth shook at the presence of God Nahum 1:5 Mountains quake because of Him. And the hills dissolve; Indeed the earth is upheaved by His presence, The world and all the inhabitants in it.

Matthew 27:52 The tombs were opened, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised 53 and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the holy city and appeared to many.

Verse 39 When the centurion, who was standing right in front of Him, saw the way He breathed His last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"
