#### Eyewitnesses

Luke 1:1 Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile an account of the things accomplished among us, 2 just as they were handed down to us by those who from the beginning <u>were eyewitnesses</u> and servants of the word, 3 it seemed fitting for me as well, having investigated everything carefully from the beginning, to write it out for you in consecutive order, most excellent Theophilus; 2 Peter 1:16 we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty 1 John 1:3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son John 19:35 And <u>he who has seen</u> has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you also may believe.

Acts 2:22 "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God <u>performed through Him in your midst</u>, just as you yourselves <u>know</u>—Acts 26:24 Festus said in a loud voice, "Paul, you are out of your mind! Your great learning is driving you mad." 25 But Paul said, "I am not out of my mind, most excellent Festus, but I utter words of sober truth. 26 "For the king <u>knows</u> about these matters, and I speak to him also <u>with confidence</u>, since I am persuaded that <u>none of these things escape his notice</u>; for <u>this has not been done in a corner</u>.

<u>Eusebius</u> The elder [Apostle John] used to say this also; 'Mark having been the interpreter of Peter, wrote down accurately all that he [Peter] mentioned, whether sayings or doings of Christ, not, however in order. ... Mark made no mistake... for he paid attention to this one thing, not to omit anything that he had heard, not to include any false statement among them

Irenaeus, <u>Matthew</u> published his Gospel among the Hebrews in their own tongue, when Peter and Paul were preaching the gospel in Rome and founding the church there. <u>Mark</u> the disciple and interpreter of Peter, himself handed down to us in writing the substance of Peter's preaching. <u>Luke</u>, the follower of Paul, set down in a book the gospel, preached by His teacher. Then <u>John</u>, the disciple of the Lord, who also leaned on his breast, himself produced his gospel, while he was living at Ephesus in Asia
