#### **Theology**

2 Corinthians 5:17 if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

Romans 6:6-7 knowing this, that our <u>old self was crucified with Him</u>, that our body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin; 7 for he who has died is freed from sin.

Ephesians 4:22-24 22 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, 23 and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and put on the new self, which is the likeness of God.

Colossians 3:9-10 Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the one who created him

Romans 7:21 I find then the principle that evil is present in me, the one who wishes to do good. 22 For I joyfully concur with the law of God in the inner man, 23 but I see a different law in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind, and making me a prisoner of the law of sin which is in my members.

Romans 7:24 Wretched man that I am! Who will set me free from the body of this death? 25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind am serving the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh the law of sin.

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
