SEVEN WAYS THAT REFLECT THAT THE CHURCH MATTERS TO CHRIST:

I. CHRIST <u>CREATED</u> THE CHURCH (32; cp. Matthew 16:18)

The church is God's plan for the ages.

Marks its uniqueness.

II. CHRIST LOVES THE CHURCH (25; cp. Acts 20:28)

The church is the object of Christ's affections.

Marks its importance.

III. CHRIST IS THE <u>HEAD</u> OF THE CHURCH (23-24, 30; 4:15-16)

Christ is the Sovereign Lord of the church.

Marks our obedience to Christ.

IV. CHRIST BAPTIZES US INTO THE CHURCH (30; cp. I Cor. 12:13)

Christ places us into His Body, the church.

Marks our participation in the life and ministry of the church.

V. CHRIST INDWELLS THE CHURCH (29; cp. John 15:4; Col. 1:27)

Christ dwells within us by the Holy Spirit

Marks the dependence the church has on Christ.

VI. CHRIST <u>PERFECTS</u> THE CHURCH (26-27; cp. Acts 2:42; I Cor. 3:16-17; 2 Tim. 3:16-17)

Christ desires a holy church.

Marks the holiness of the believers in the church.

VII. CHRIST IS <u>GLORIFIED</u> IN THE CHURCH (27; 1:7, 12, 14; 3:21; 2 Cor. 11:2; Rev. 19:6-9)

The object of the church is the glory of Christ.

Marks the ultimate purpose of our existence: live for the glory of God.
