Numbers 12:3 Now the man Moses was very humble, more than any man who was on the face of the earth. Acts 20:19 serving the Lord with all humility 1 Peter 5:5-6 All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble. Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time Matthew 11:29 gentle and humble in heart
