The exaltation of 'Christ, the humble' Philippians 2:9-11

Introduction:

Philippians 2:9 For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

1 Peter 5:5 ...and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble. 6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time,

Two choices: be a 'self-exalter' or be 'God-exalted'

John 17:5 <i>Father,</i>	glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was
John 5:22 <i>For not</i>	even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son.

#3 The : of the Father exalting the Son 10-11a

Romans 10:9 ...that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Revelation 20:15 ... if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. 1 Timothy 1:16 ...found mercy, so that in me as the foremost [of sinners], Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life.

#3 The RESULTS: of the Father exalting the Son - continued

Romans 10:9 If you confess with your mouth **Jesus as Lord**, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; John 20:28 Thomas ... said to Him, "**My Lord** and my God!"

Confess Him now in praise, OR you will confess Him later in punishment.

Bow before Christ the LORD <u>now</u> in salvation OR you will bow before Christ the LORD <u>later</u> in condemnation

Luke 6:46 Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? Matthew 7:21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. John 3:36 "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

James 2:26 ... faith without works is dead. 1 Corinthians 6:9 Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Ephesians 5:5 you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, ..., has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. Galatians 5:21 envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, ... those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Hebrews 12:14 Pursue ... sanctification without which no one will see the Lord.

Romans 6:17 thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became **obedient from the heart** to that form of teaching to which you were committed

Acts 2:36... God has made Him both Lord and Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified.

A continually sinning 'so-called Christian', is either in disobedience, awaiting discipline, OR in defiance, awaiting damnation.
