• 12Our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13Take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day (Ephesians 6:12-13).

³As I urged you upon my departure for Macedonia,

[You] remain on at Ephesus

so that you may instruct certain men

not to teach strange doctrines,

⁴nor to pay attention to myths and endless genealogies,

which give rise to mere speculation

rather than furthering the administration of God

which is by faith.

- Among these are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan, so that they will be taught not to blaspheme (1
 Timothy 1:20).
- ... the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth (1 Timothy 3:15b).
- ⁹But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the Law, for they are unprofitable and worthless.

 10 Reject a factious man after a first and second warning, 11 knowing that such a man is perverted and is sinning, being self-condemned (Titus 3:9–11).
- ³For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, ⁴and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths (2 Timothy 4:3-4).
