Three Challenges for Women as they consider God's High Calling in their life

1. Aspire to _____ to others (9-10)

John 13:3-9 » Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he had come from God and was going back to God, ⁴ rose from supper. He laid aside his outer garments, and taking a towel, tied it around his waist.⁵ Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him. ⁶ He came to Simon Peter, who said to him, "Lord, do you wash my feet?" ⁷ Jesus answered him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but afterward you will understand." ⁸ Peter said to him, "You shall never wash my feet." Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no share with me." ⁹ Simon Peter said to him, "Lord, not my feet only but also my hands and my head!"

Ephesians 2:10 » - For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

2. Watch out for losing your (11-13)

Numbers 30:9 » · But any vow of a widow or of a divorced woman, anything by which she has bound herself, shall stand against her.

Ecclesiastes 5:5–6 ». It is better that you should not vow than that you should vow and not pay. Let not your mouth lead you into sin, and do not say before the messenger that it was a mistake. Why should God be angry at your voice and destroy the work of your hands?

3. Prioritize your ______ above all others (14-16)

Titus 2:3–5 » ³ Older women... are to teach what is good, ⁴ and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, ⁵ to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled.
