**Micah 7:18-19** Who is a God like You, who pardons iniquity and passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession? He does not retain His anger forever, because He delights in unchanging love. <sup>19</sup> He will again have compassion on us; He will tread our iniquities under foot. Yes, You will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.

**Psalm 130:3-4** If You, Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? <sup>4</sup> But there is forgiveness with You, that You may be feared.

**Psalm 49:12** But man in *his* pomp will not endure; He is like the beasts that perish.

**Psalm 100:5** For the Lord is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting and His faithfulness to all generations.

**Jeremiah 31:3** The Lord appeared to him from afar, *saying*, "I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness.

### 4. Overflowing heart, \_\_\_\_\_ v20-22
