2 Timothy 2:11-13 11 It is a trustworthy statement:

For if we died with Him, we will also live with Him;

- 12 If we endure, we will also reign with <u>Him;</u> If we deny <u>Him, He</u> also will deny us;
- 13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.

- 1 Timothy 4:9 <u>It is a trustworthy statement</u> deserving full acceptance.
- 2 Timothy 2:11 It is a trustworthy statement: For if we died with Him, we will also live with Him;
- Titus 3:8 This is a trustworthy statement; ...those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds.
