Introduction:

REVELATION God's disclosure of Himself to mankind

2 Peter 1:20 But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, 21 for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

INSPIRATION The Holy Spirit wrote through the biblical writers using their own languages,

culture and individual personalities, resulting in God's Word without error in the original.

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God

Matthew 5:17-20 not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass away from the Law, until all is accomplished

<u>INERRANCY</u> God's superintendence of the human authors so that, using their own individual personalities, they composed and recorded, WITHOUT ERROR, His revelation to man in the words of the original autographs.

Numbers 23:19 God is not a man that He should lie Malachi 3:6 For I the Lord do not change. John 10:34-36 The Scripture cannot be broken. John 17:17 Thy word is truth.

CANONICITY God uses specific men to record His scripture—Prophets and Apostles.

Ephesians 2:20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets

John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. 2 Peter 3:15 just as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you, 16 as also in all his letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction. Jude 3 Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all handed down to the saints.

<u>AUTHORITY</u> God is the absolute authority, so His WORD is the authoritative revelation of HIS WILL to His children.

The Scriptures were not given for our information, but for our transformation.

<u>ILLUMINATION</u> The operation of the Holy Spirit whereby He makes known to regenerate men the spiritual content, significance, application, and truth of the Bible.

1 Corinthians 2:14-15 But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised. But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no man.
