1. Are you the person who's doing well in these things? Thank God for His kindness to you and excel still more.

- 3. Are you the person who needs to turn from sin in order to remove the roadblock which is preventing you from thirsting? Consider v. 1 and put those sins away today. Repent and choose to obey your Lord.
- 4. Or, are you the person who doesn't even know what it's like to live with this kind of thirst for God? Seek Him now. Be born again. Repent from your sin and turn to Christ for salvation today. He is faithful to forgive and grant eternal life.
