### CHURCH GROWTH REPORTS IN ACTS ...

Those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls (Acts 2:41).

The Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved (Acts 2:47b).

All the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to their number (Acts 5:14).

The word of God kept on spreading; and <u>the number</u> of the disciples <u>continued to increase greatly</u> in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were becoming obedient to the faith (Acts 6:7).

The church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, <u>it continued to increase</u> (Acts 9:31).

The word of the Lord continued to grow and to be multiplied (Acts 12:24).

The churches were being strengthened in the faith, and were increasing in number daily (Acts 16:5).

The word of the Lord was growing mightily and prevailing (Acts 19:20).

And [Paul] stayed two full years in his own rented quarters and was welcoming all who came to him, <u>preaching</u> the kingdom of God and <u>teaching</u> concerning the Lord Jesus Christ <u>with all openness</u>, <u>unhindered</u> (Acts 28:30–31).

Jesus said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth" (Acts 1:8).
