# Acts 28:1-16

# God is faithful, even when we can't see how.

#### 1. God's ways are not our ways. (28:1-6)

**Isaiah 55:8–9** » For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. <sup>9</sup> For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

**Romans 11:33** » Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!

**Isaiah 40:28** » Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable.

**Proverbs 3:5–6** » Trust in the Lord with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight.

## 2. Your labor may not bear visible fruit. (28:6-10)

**Hebrews 2:3–4** » how will we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? After it was at the first spoken through the Lord, it was confirmed to us by those who heard, <sup>4</sup> God also testifying with them, both by signs and wonders and by various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will. (cf, 2 Cor 12:12)

**2 Timothy 2:4–7** » No <u>soldier</u> gets entangled in civilian pursuits, since his aim is to please the one who enlisted him. <sup>5</sup> An <u>athlete</u> is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules. <sup>6</sup> It is the hard-working <u>farmer</u> who ought to have the first share of the crops. <sup>7</sup> Think over what I say, for the Lord will give you understanding in everything.

**Galatians 6:9–10** » And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. <sup>10</sup> So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

**1 Peter 2:12** » Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God <u>on the day of visitation</u>.

### 3. All the world serves the plan of God. (28:11-16)

Matthew 8:27 » And the men marveled, saying, "What sort of man is this, that even winds and sea obey him?"

**Romans 1:11–12** » <sup>11</sup> For I long to see you ... <sup>12</sup> that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine. (cf, 1 Thess 5:10-11)

Acts 2:23 » this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. (cf, Acts 4:27-28)

**Romans 15:29–32** » I know that when I come to you I will come in the fullness of the blessing of Christ. <sup>30</sup> I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf, <sup>31</sup> that I may be delivered from the unbelievers in Judea, and that my service for Jerusalem may be acceptable to the saints, <sup>32</sup> so that by God's will I may come to you with joy and be refreshed in your company.

**Ephesians 5:15–16** » <sup>15</sup> Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, <sup>16</sup> making the best use of the time, because the days are evil.
