James Boice Joy is based upon the knowledge of who God is and what He has done for us in Christ. 'Happiness' is dependent upon circumstances—while joy is not.
MacArthur Joy is a deep, abiding inner thankfulness to God for his goodness that is not diminished or interrupted when less-than-desirable circumstances intrude on one's life.
Psalm 22:11 Be not far from me, for trouble is near.
1 Corinthians 7:28 In this life, you will have trouble.
Romans 8:28 We know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.
Matthew 13:20-21 "The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it witl joy; yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away."
