Introduction:

John 15:16 You did not choose Me but I chose you

God is sovereign but you are responsible

James 4:7 Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom. **10** Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

2 Corinthians 7:10 For the sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation, ... 11 For behold what earnestness this very thing, this godly sorrow, has produced in you: what vindication of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what longing, what zeal, what avenging of wrong!

2nd Loyal internal singlemindedness 8c and purify your hearts, you double-minded

George Whitefield Every man by his own natural will hates God. But when he is turned to the Lord by repentance, then his will is changed; his conscience becomes quickened; his hard heart is melted, and his unruly affections are crucified. Through repentance, his entire soul is transformed, he will have new inclinations, new desires, and new habits.
