Genesis 2:18 » Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."

John 17:20-21 » (I pray) "for those also who believe in Me through their word; that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me.

Ephesians 4:1–3 » Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, ² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, ³ being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Colossians 4:6 » Let your speech always be with grace, *as though* seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

Galatians 6:2 » Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

What We Teach » Man » Created
