Love like you've been forgiven much

1. _____ above all the Person of Christ (36-38)

John 6:68 » Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life."

2. _____ from judging in place of Christ (39-40)

James 4:12 » There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the One who is able to save and destroy

3. _____ your debt paid by Christ (41-47)

Luke 18:9-13 » And He also told this parable to some people who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and viewed others with contempt: Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and was praying this to himself: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other people: swindlers, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week: I pay tithes of all that I get.' But the tax collector, standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift up his eyes to heaven, but was beating his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, the sinner!'"

4. _____ in the saving work of Christ (48-50)

1 Corinthians 6:11 » Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.
